

## NIEUW BESCHREVEN CONTINENTALE MOLLUSKENSOORTEN (NEW TAXA: CONTINENTAL MOLLUSCS)

*Newly described species, rubricated at the family levels, with references to the malacological papers in which they were introduced.*

### CAMAENIDAE

- \* *Solaropsis chicomendesi*. Described by CUEZZO & FERNÁNDEZ (2001, The Veliger, 44 (3): 315-324) from Santo Corazón, Santa Cruz Department, Bolivia.

### CERESIDAE

- \* *Tozerpina bitssi parva* and *Tozerpina lenticis*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

### CLAUSILIIDAE

- \* *Alopia (Kimakowiczia) maciana*. Described by BADARAU & SZEKERES (2001, Archiv für Molluskenkunde, 129 (1-2): 65-68) from the Gilau-Muntele Mare mountains, Romania.
- \* Four new genera: *Celsiphaedusa*, *Macrophaedusella*, *Seriphaedusa* and *Bathyptichia*. Six new subgenera: *Bathyptichia* (*Bathyptichia*), *Bathyptichia* (*Stric-tiphaedusa*), *Hemiphaedusa* (*Hemiphae-dusoides*), *Hemiphaedusa* (*Labyrinthiphae-dusa*), *Hemiphaedusa* (*Margaritiphaedusa*), and *Phaedusa* (*Metaphaedusa*). Ten new species: *Bathyptichia* (*B.*) *martensi*, *Euphaedusa* *costifera*, *E. krejci*, *E. yunnan-cola*, *Hemiphaedusa* (*Synprosphyma*) *ehr-manni*, *H. (S.) pseudoinversa*, *Macrophae-dusella* *jesuitica*, *Oospira* (*Formosana*) *schawalleri*, *Phaedusa* (*P.*) *boettgeri*, *P. (Metaphaedusa) pseudaculus*. Five new subspecies: *Euphaedusa* *gemina* *davidi*, *Hemiphaedusa* (*H.*) *pluvialis* *zilchi*, *H. (Margaritiphaedusa) protrita* *huancola*, *H. (M.) rusticana* *amoena* and *Phaedusa* (*P.*) *potanini* *pretiosa*. Described by H. NORD-SIECK (2001, Archiv für Molluskenkunde, 129 (1-2): 25-63) from mainland China.

### CYCLOPHORIDAE

- \* *Chamalyceus tangmaiensis* and *Dioryx tangmaiensis*. Described by CHEN & ZHANG (2001, Acta Zootaxonomica Sini-ca, 26 (1): 11-17) from Tongmai Town, Bomi County, Tibet.

### EMMERICIIDAE

- \* *Choerina todina* and *Choerina tudertis*. Described by ESU & GIROTTI (2001, Archiv für Molluskenkunde, 129 (1-2): 123-143) from Pliocene lacustrine clays at Todi, Umbria, Italy.
- \* *Emmericia cauponia*. Described by ESU & GIROTTI (2001, Archiv für Mollusken-

kunde, 129 (1-2): 123-143) from uppermost Miocene/lower Pliocene lacustrine clays at Sambuca, Val di Pesa, Tuscany, Italy.

- \* *Emmericia mollonensis*. Described by TRUC (2001, Archiv für Molluskenkunde, 129 (1-2): 123-143) from the late Mio-cene of Ravin de Mollon, Dép. Ain, France.

### ENIDAE

- \* *Ena markamensis*. Described by CHEN & ZHANG (2001, Acta Zootaxonomica Sini-ca, 26 (1): 11-17) from Chubalung Town, Markam County, Tibet.

### GASTRODONTIDAE

- \* *Nesokaliella intermedia*. Described by GERLACH (2001, Journal of Conchology, 37 (2): 205-212) from the island Silhouette, Seychelles.

### HELICINIDAE

- \* *Lucidella salishora* and *Lucidella colum-biana*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

### HELMINTHOGLYPTIDAE

- \* *Xeranionta constenii*. A tertiary fossil described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

### HUMBOLDTIANIDAE

- \* *Skinnerelix rothi*. A tertiary fossil described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.
- \* *Humboldtiana gradyi*, *H. pinicola*, *H. bicincta*, *H. edesma*, *H. latizona*, *H. porte-rae*, and *H. oreina*. Described by THOMPSON & BREWER (2000, Bulletin of the Florida Museum of Natural History, 43 (2): 49-77) from the Mexican states Nuevo León, Zacatecas, Durango, Querétaro and Coahuila. Two new subgenera were established: *Oreades* and *Polyomphala*.

### HYDROBIIDAE

- \* *Pyrgulopsis bedfordensis*. Described by HERSHLER & GUSTAFSON (2000, Proceedings of the Biological Society of Washington, 114 (1): 297-307) from headwa-ter region of the Missouri River basin from southwest Montana (U.S.A.).

\* *Tryonia russelli*, *Cincinnatia?* *bowmanana* and *Fluminicola calderense*. Tertiary fos-sils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

\* *Bythiospeum alzense*. A new name proposed by BOETERS (2001, Archiv für Mol-luskenkunde, 129 (1): 145-147) for a speci-ies formerly described from Burgkirchen, Bavaria, Germany.

\* *Boetersiella* and *Chondrobasis*. Two new genera described by ARCONADA & RAMOS (2001, Journal of Natural History, 35: 949-984) from Spain.

\* *Boetersiella davisi*. Described by ARCO-NADA & RAMOS (2001, Journal of Natural History, 35: 949-984) from Durcal and Padul (Granada, Spain).

\* *Chondrobasis levantina*. described by RAMOS & ARCONADA (2001, Journal of Natural History, 35: 949-984) from five provinces from the east of Spain.

### HYGROMIIDAE


\* *Trochoidea (Xerocrassa) robesi*. Described by MARTÍNEZ-ORTÍ (2000, IBERUS, 18 (2): 31-39) from Sierra Calderona, Valencia, Spain.

### LYMNAEIDAE

\* *Lymnaea bowmanana* and *Lymnaea lacerta*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

### MELANOPSIDAE

\* *Melanopsis sigmocorrugata*. Mid-Pleisto-cene fossil described by HELLER & SIVAN (2001, Journal of Conchology, 37 (2): 127-147) from Gesher Benot Ya'aqov, Hula Valley, Israel.

## OREOHELICIDAE

- \* *Oreohelix dawsonae* and *Radiocentrum kintlana*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## PLANORBIDAE

- \* *Helisoma triangulata*, *Planorbella fordensis*, *Biomphalaria spirula*, *Menetus texanus* and *Menetus hilli*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.
- \* *Kessneria papillosa*. A new genus and new species described by WALKER & PONDER (2001, Journal of Molluscan Studies, 67 (2): 153-160) from the Adelaide River, Northern Territory, Australia.

## PLEUROCERIDAE

- \* *Doryssa ipupiara*. Described by SIMONE (2001, Arquivos de Zoologia, 36 (2): 147-263) from Maracá Island (Apui Lake, Roraima, Brazil).

## POLYGYRIDAE

- \* *Praticolella lucifera*. A tertiary fossil described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## PUPILLIDAE

- \* *Pupoides costatus*. A tertiary fossil

described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

- \* *Pupilla quyuensis*. Described by CHEN & ZHANG (2001, Acta Zootaxonomica Sinica, 26 (1): 11-17) from Leicun Town, Zayu County, Tibet.

## SPHAERIIDAE

- \* *Sphaerium discus*. A tertiary fossil described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## SUBULINIDAE

- \* *Tortaxis xiazayuensis*. Described by CHEN & ZHANG (2001, Acta Zootaxonomica Sinica, 26 (1): 11-17) from Xiazayu Town, Zayu County, China.

## SUCCINEIDAE

- \* *Oxyloma? kintlana* and *Omalonyx coccare*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## THIARIDAE

- \* *Aylacostoma explicata* and *Aylacostoma ci*. Described by SIMONE (2001, Arquivos de Zoologia, 36 (2): 147-263) from the Caraipé River (Tucurui, Brazil) and Jamarí River (Rondônia, Brazil), respectively.

## UROCOPTIDAE

- \* *Holospira tabrumi*, *Holospira beardi* and *Coelostemma dawsonae*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## VALLONIIDAE

- \* *Vallonia kootenayorum*. A tertiary fossil described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## VALVATIDAE

- \* *Valvata procera spatiosa*. A tertiary fossil described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## VERTIGINIDAE

- \* *Gastrocpta kintlana*, *Gastrocpta akokala*, *Vertigo consteniusi*, *Vertigo dolliara* and *Vertigo micra*. Tertiary fossils described by PIERCE & CONSTENIUS (2001, Annals of Carnegie Museum, 70 (1): 1-112) from the northern Kishenehn Basin, Montana/British Columbia.

## VITRINIDAE

- \* *Plutonia (Insulivitina) solemi*. Described by IBÁÑEZ & ALONSO (2001, Journal of Conchology, 37 (2): 149-157) from various localities on La Palma, Canary Islands.
